Highways – Potholes in Mark Road and deterioration of road surface in Halterpath Drove have been reported to Highways Dept. Potholes in Westhay Broad drove have been repaired.

Drainage Board are hoping to carryout work on culverts to alleviate flooding by pond in Robins Lane.

Planning The following applications have been granted by Sedgemoor District Council

55/20/00008 Demolition of ancillary storage/classroom and stone outbuildings and erection of a single dwelling with integral garage, widening of existing vehicular entrance and erection of an ancillary unit of holiday accommodation on site of Dutch barn (to be demolished) at Chapel Hill Farm, Mark Road, Burtle

55/20/00009 Change of use of land from highways to residential use in order to facilitate the erection of a new boundary wall at site of Burtle Inn, Catcott Broad Drove, Burtle. **NB** This only relates to planning permission. Separate application has to be made to Department for Transport to stop up the highway.

Traffic through the Village less than satisfactory reply received from Traffic Engineer regarding the unfinished white lining in the village and other issues discussed at site meeting. New Officer now in post - email to be sent to clarify situation.
