Burtle Parish Council Summary – April 2019

Highways List of items requiring attention to be sent to Highways including: **Badger damage** – Robins Lane. **Road surface** – Halterpath Drove, **Edge erosion** – Westhay Broad Drove and Tile House Road, **Potholes** – Edington Road, **Reflectors and Slow signs** – Redgate, Burtle Road.

New lake by the Peat works is also a cause for concern as it is very deep now and the condition and angle of the road would make it very easy to lose control and enter the water, particularly as the road is often covered in mud. Cllrs have asked whether a safety barrier could be erected. There is a similar situation on the Burtle side of the peat works where the vegetation has been cut back exposing a deep rhyne.

Parish Council Election Will be uncontested as there were just five nominations. The existing Parish Councillors will continue for a further term.

District Council Election Will be contested on 2nd May as there are two candidates for the seat.

Village Spring Clean took place on 7th April after being postponed because of high winds in March. Thanks to all those who took part.
