

Summary of Burtle Parish Council Meeting – March 2022

Highways Areas of subsidence in Edington Road by the cattery have still not been repaired despite being marked out at the end of last year. Clerk to remind Highways Dept again.

Speed Indicator Device Somerset County Council need to agree proposed sites and type of Speed indicator device to be purchased. Clerk to provide all information to the Traffic Engineer together with a request for a site visit with representative from the Parish Council to progress the matter as soon as possible.

Enforcement Issues Still no response from Sedgemoor DC Enforcement Department about issues that have been outstanding for several years in some instances. However, Cllrs are encouraged to learn that Sedgemoor has recently appointed a new Enforcement Officer. New tipping in Catcott Broad Drove to be reported.

Village Spring Clean Spring clean of the village verges and ditches agreed as Sunday 6th March. Parish Council will provide refreshments for all volunteers.

Storm damage Unfortunately, storm Eunice caused serious damage to some of the trees on the Sandpit. Emergency safety work has been carried out and Cllrs will look in to planting replacement trees.

Queen's Platinum Jubilee Cllrs agreed to purchase a commemorative mug for every young person in the village aged sixteen or under.
