Summary of Burtle Parish Council Meeting – March 2024

Highways Cllrs are pleased to see that the large pothole in centre of the carriageway in Edington Road has been repaired although others in the vicinity have not been repaired.

Bridge at Redgate, Reflector posts are listed for replacement but news of bridge repairs still awaited.

Damage to railings at Black Ditch Rhyne, Westhay Road have asked their contractors to monitor safety of the barriers and have said that repairs will be carried out as soon as practicable.

Flooding It is the responsibility of riparian owners to keep ditches and rhynes clear. Following the recent heavy rain several ditches in the area have been cleared and a request has been made to Highways dept to jet gullies in the village which appear to be blocked.

Traffic through the village SID continues to be rotated between the designated spots around the village

Planning Councillors unanimously agreed to support application for change of use of agricultural land to domestic curtilage at Cherry Tree Barn, Robins Lane, Burtle

Somerset Planning - North has granted permission for the erection of a two storey extension to the side (NE) elevation, single storey extension to the rear (NW) elevation on site of existing conservatory (to be demolished), and front porch to the (SE) elevation on site of existing porch (to be demolished). at 3 Station Road, Burtle
